In terms of para 8 of DoP&T OM No.142/40/2015-AVD.I dated 8.10.2015, the number of cases assigned to an Inquiry officer be restricted to 20 (Twenty) cases in a year and not more than 4 (four) cases at a time. Therefore, whenever a need arises for appointment of an IO, a request may be made to Jt.CGA & CVO by the field offices, so that the aforementioned guidelines of DoP&T are complied with.
