Sub:- Observance of Vigilance Awareness Week 2015

v) Debate on the subject **“Has the new initiative and technology prevented the corruption to grow and can it eradicate the corruption from Government Machinery”** in English or in Hindi would be organized for officers and staff of CGA office, on **29th October, 2015 at 2.30 P.M. at ‘Swasti’** with three cash prizes of Rs 3000/-, Rs 2000/- and Rs 1500/- respectively for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd winners. The officers and staff of this office, who are interested in participating in the competition, may give their names to Vigilance Section by 28th October, 2015 positively.

3. All the officers and staff of office of CGA who will participate in the event of essay writing and debate competition will be given Rs. 200/- as consolation prize (except prize winners).
